For the City of Hardin

This message is just a precaution.

The drinking water intake for the city of Hardin is located on the Big Horn River and due to recent river level increases and fast moving water which may cause flooding in the Big Horn River there is concern for our intake. The city wants to keep the public informed of the situation as it relates to our drinking water system. Dikes have been built to protect our intake and piping at the river. City personnel are monitoring the situation and will keep the public informed.

What should I do?

There is nothing to do at this time. If there is an emergency city personnel will keep the public informed of the situation.

What does this mean?

As a precaution, conserve water.
