## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that on **18<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2022**; at 6:10 p.m. a Public Hearing will be held in the Council Chambers, located at 401 North Cheyenne Avenue, Hardin Montana and virtually by Zoom, to discuss the parking along Center Avenue from 3<sup>rd</sup> Street to 5<sup>th</sup> Street and along 3<sup>rd</sup> Street a block each direction from Center Avenue.

We encourage business owners and anyone else interested in downtown parking to attend the meeting, ask questions, and offer their ideas. The discussion will cover ideas to free up parking availability for customers of downtown businesses to aid in the economic development of our community. Some ideas already discussed have been parking limited to a certain number of hours or a change in the overall layout of parking in the downtown area.
